



Southwestern Region Distinguished Service Chapter Minimum Membership Qualifications/Guidelines

The following qualifications and guidelines are to advise and educate chapters on the minimum criteria necessary for members to be considered for the Southwestern Region DSC (Rationale: Chapters should recommend brothers who meet these criteria for the Regional DSC not a longevity record.)

- Σ Applicant must be in good standing with the National Office for the last ten consecutive years
- Σ Applicant has been an active and participating member of a local chapter for the last ten consecutive years
- Σ Applicant has attended two of the last three Regional Conferences
- Σ Applicant has attended two of the last three National Conclaves
- Σ Applicant has received two or more citations for outstanding service in his local community
- Σ Applications shall only be submitted during the year of a Regional Conference
- Σ No chapter can submit more than one application during the year of the Regional Conference

In addition to the guidelines above, the applicant will be evaluated on the following:

- Σ Professional and business affiliation
- Σ Fraternity activities and achievements
- Σ Community, civic and political activities

Failure to follow these guidelines will result in the application being rejected and/or returned.
