


Academic Achievement Scholarships



WHO: All financial collegiate brothers of the Southwestern Region are eligible to apply for scholarship awards!

WHAT: The Southwestern Region will award up to two (2) \$500.00 scholarships based upon academic achievement, campus involvement and engagement in Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc..

WHEN: April 4-7, 2024

WHERE: 72nd Southwestern Regional Conference





Scholarship Criteria

Application Requirements

- 1. Electronic form of an unofficial transcript
- 2. Copy of current resume
- 3. 3 letters of recommendation on letter head of that organization.
 - a. One must be from Chapter Advisor, Area Director, or State Director on letterhead.
 - b. One must be from School Official/Administrator
- 4. 500 Word Essay including choice of major, how you plan to utilize your degree within that chosen filed and an explanation of why you should be awarded the scholarship.
- 5. List involvement with fraternity's national programs and special events.
- 6. List leadership roles and functions in other organizations outside Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc.
 - a. Must provide supporting documentation verifying roles and responsibilities in each organization.
 - i. Letter from Dean of Students or administrative equivalent on school letterhead
 - ii. Letter from Organization Leader/Advisor on that organization's letterhead
- 7. Applicant must be financial at all levels.
- 8. Applicant must be registered for Regional Leadership Conference.
- 9. Applications must be submitted by the **March 14, 2024,** deadline for consideration.





Selection Criteria

- 1. Completed applications will be distributed to the Scholarship Committee. All applications will be submitted to the Southwestern Regional Board with the Committee's recommendations.
- 2. The Committee will make recommendations based upon a point system. The points will be based upon the following:

I. Cumulative Grade Point Average

Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.50 or better (all GPA's will be weighted equally and worth 5 points)

II. Supporting Documents

a.	Presentation of package	1-5 points
b.	Essay	1-5 points
c.	Extracurricular/Leadership activity	1-5 points

- d. Other Organization Involvement 1-5 points
 - i. 5 points President
 - ii. 4 points Vice President
 - iii. 3 points Other Elected Offices
 - iv. 2 points Committee Chairman
 - v. 1 point Member

III. Service in Sigma

- i. 5 points Chapter President
- ii. 4 points Chapter Vice President
- iii. 3 points Other Chapter Officers
- iv. 3 points International/Regional Committees
- v. 1 point Member
